Application Guidelines and Regulations

I. **【Event Origin】:**

Among the many types of musical instruments, the flute stands out for both its artistic value in performance and the craftsmanship of the instrument itself. According to statistics, the number of people learning flute ranks among the top three around the world, alongside the piano and violin. However, in Taiwan, opportunities to promote the art of the flute from a global perspective are relatively limited. Therefore, we hope to invite internationally renowned flute players, along with several flutists from Hong Kong, Macau, and local Taiwan, to join and share their experiences and knowledge, pushing the local artistry to new heights.

(3) Transfer the application fees by using the chosen payment method.

(4) Please settle the payment and respond with additional information within **three days** after receiving the confirmation email from the organizer.

※Completion of the above process and submission of the required documents will be considered as a successful registration only after confirmation by the organizing committee.

2. Itinerary:

(1) **Professional group:**

Two lessons with American or European Maestros,
Three lessons with Asian faculty,
Ten lectures in total,
Joint-faculty opening concert,
*Closing student concert.

(2) **Amateur Group:**

Two lessons with Asian faculty,
Four chamber coaching sessions,
Ten lectures in total,
Joint-faculty opening concert,
Closing student chamber concert.

3. Each lesson is scheduled to last 40 minutes (excluding lectures).
4. The lessons with European and American instructors will be randomly assigned by the organizing committee.
5. The Asian instructors will be divided into two teaching groups, A and B. Preferences for group assignment will be selected after successful registration. The organizing committee reserves the right to make the final grouping decisions.

6. All lessons throughout the camp are open for participants from both the Professional and Amateur Groups to sit in. Seats are limited, and the organizer reserves the right to manage the total number of sit-in students in each class.
7. Except for the pre-assigned private lesson schedule, participants in both groups are free to customize their own timetable with sit-in schedules.
8. Participants who fully engage in the entire event and demonstrate outstanding performance will be awarded a completion certificate during the closing ceremony.◦

* Closing Student Concert will be conducted for the Professional Group, where five Rising Star performers will be selected by the faculty to present their distinguished achievements.

1. Cancellations made before 31st December, 2023, are eligible for a **90%** refund of both the application and accommodation fees.
2. Cancellations made between 1st January and 31st March, 2024, are eligible for a **50%** refund of both the application and accommodation fees.
3. No refunds will be issued for cancellations made on or after 1st April, 2024.

X. 【Event Transportation】:

1. The organizer will arrange dedicated transportation between Howard Plaza Hotel and the Department of Music at Tunghai University. There will be two trips each morning and two trips after the evening activities each day.
2. Non-residential participants are responsible for arranging their transportation to the Department of Music at Tunghai University.
3. Participants are responsible for the safety and legal obligations of their own commuting when using transportation methods not arranged by the organizer.
